

U.S. Silica Gains Approval for Development of New Mine and Plant Near Fairchild, Wisconsin

(SLCA) today announced that it has received approval from the Town of Fairchild, WI to begin development of a new, three million ton-per-year frac sand mine and plant. The proposed state-of-the-art facility, which will be served by the Union Pacific Railroad, is anticipated to become operational by the fourth guarter of 2015.
